RE: Kingswood Residential Reminders

Dear Parents/ Carers,

A reminder of essential details for the Kingswood Residential Trip:

The 4th of June is a non-pupil day; children attending the Residential Trip should arrive at school between 9:30am and 9.45am. Please enter school via the hall side door with all of their luggage, ready to head off for Kingswood.

On the day:

- Medication should be brought into school in a clear bag, labelled with the child's name and DOB. All medication must be in its original packaging with the patient information leaflet included. This **must** be brought in by an adult and the adult must complete a school medication form.
- Pupils can bring a maximum of £5 spending money in a labelled wallet or purse.

Both of the above must be handed directly to a member of staff.

- **No mobile phones or electronic devices.** If your child would like to bring a camera it must be disposable.
- A named water bottle that the children can refill in between activities
- Please triple check the kit list and ensure all items are packed including a waterproof coat, long sleeves and trousers and sun cream. I can now confirm a swimming kit is **not** necessary.

We are planning to leave at 10.15am, please do stay to wave us off if you would like to. The children will need a **home-prepared packed lunch** as, when we arrive at Kingswood, we will be having lunch by the beach. As it is a non-pupil day the school kitchen will **not** be open and therefore unable to provide this.

We will let you know when we safely arrive, and will keep you updated via text as to our arrival time back to school.

We look forward to going on what promises to be a very exciting adventure.
