## Universal Free School Meals END for ALL Year Two Pupils on 21<sup>st</sup> July 17

From 4<sup>th</sup> September, when all current Year 2 pupils become Year 3, school lunches will be chargeable at £1.85 per meal.

Parents can either order school lunches (via the lunch from sent home last week) for the first two weeks we return in September or can send children in with a home made packed lunches.

Any meals ordered (to be taken) from 5<sup>th</sup> September 2017 will be charged at £1.85 per meal.

Meals **must** be paid for in advance of consumption via the schools on line payment system, SIM's Agora.
