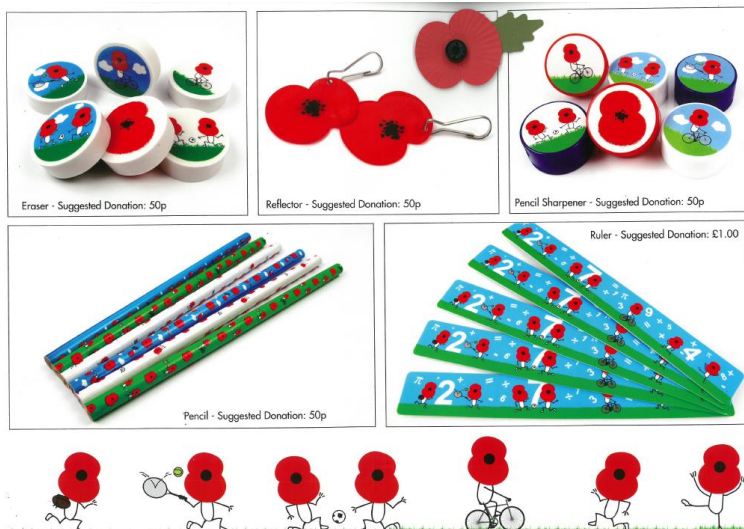

We do not expect your water supply to be affected, but we do want to make you aware that the footway will be closed for the duration of our works, which are due to be completed on **02/11/2018.**

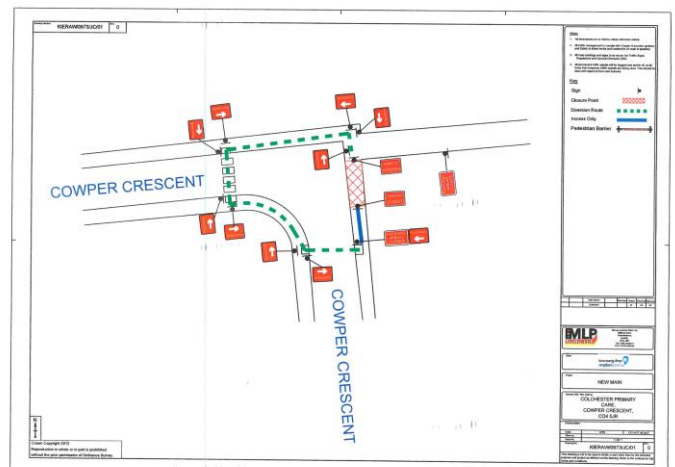
We would respectfully request all residents not to park at the above address so our teams can get the work carried out as quickly and efficiently as possible.
