Term Time Holidays – An Important Reminder

We are concerned to note the seemingly constant stream of 'Applications For Term Time Leave of Absence' forms submitted by parents of Queen Boudica pupils. Term times are for education, pupils and families have 175 days off school, including weekends and school holidays, to spend time together. Taking children out of school during term time can be detrimental to children's educational progress. There is no entitlement to parents to take their children out of school during term time.

The school will only authorise a term time holiday in genuinely exceptional circumstance. Where an unauthorised holiday is taken, the school will request that a penalty notice be issued (through Essex County via Attendance Solutions) to each parent of £60* for each child taken out of school. *Increasing to £120 if not paid within 21 days.

IMPORTANT:- New legislation comes into force from September 2018 whereby Penalty Notices can (and will) be issued to parents/carers of any pupils that have 6 sessions (3days) or more of unauthorised absences recorded during the first two weeks of September. Queen Boudica Primary School will be enforcing these Penalty Notices to discourage absences at this vital. start of new academic year. time.
