EYFS

In EYFS this week we have enjoyed the story of 'Handa's Surprise'. We have introduced story terms 'setting' meaning where the story happens, 'character' meaning who is in the story and 'event' meaning what happens in the story. We have also tried some different fruits, talking about healthy eating. The children were very good at trying these fruits and we know a few discovered new favourites. The pomegranate, for example, went down well!

The children have been continuing and creating patterns, looking at which parts 'repeat'. They used colour, shape, size and rhythm (with the African drums). They have also been creative making African necklaces, printing pineapples and painting animals.

Next Tuesday 21st November, we invite you in at 2.30pm to enjoy the children telling the story of 'The Little Red Hen'. Following there will be time to share story books with your child before coming together for a final story. We do hope you can make it.
