## EYFS

This week in EYFS we have been getting ready for our Nativity performances next week. We do hope you will be able to come along to one of the performances!

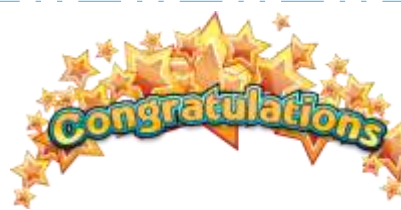
