# Healthy Packed Lunches Things to remember...

When preparing healthy packed lunches please bear these few things in mind.....

We are a completely nut free school so <u>no nuts of any kind</u> (including spreads containing nuts) should be included in lunch bags. <u>No chocolate spread</u> sandwiches.

Confectionary and sweets are NOT permitted however children can have one chocolate type biscuit (eg Penguin, Rocky, 2 finger Kit Kat or similar) as part of their balanced, packed lunch.

When including grapes in a packed lunch please ensure that they have been cut in half, length ways, to minimise the risk of choking. This is County guidance.

No carbonated (fizzy) drinks. Only fruit juice, squash or water.

All lunch bags and drink bottles should be named, this will help lost items find their way back to the rightful owners. Thank you for your understanding and co-operation.

Important:- Any disallowed items will be kept for children to take home at the end of the school day.
